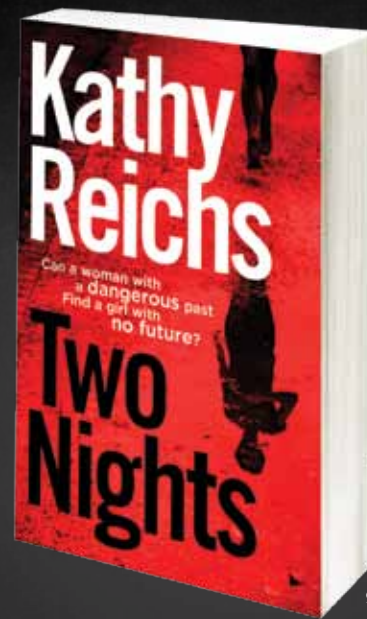
THE LAST SON'S SECRET

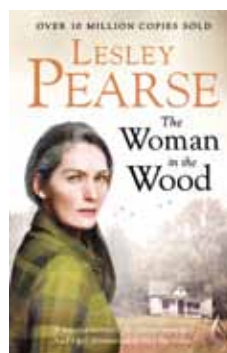

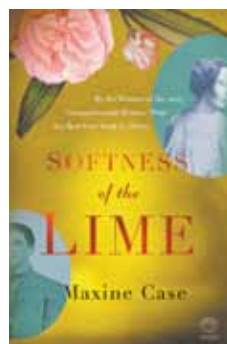
