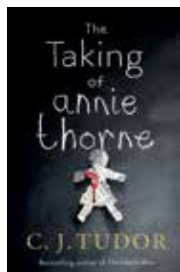

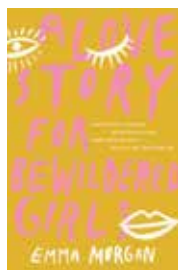

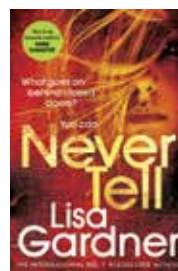
### A LOVE STORY FOR BEWILDERED GIRLS

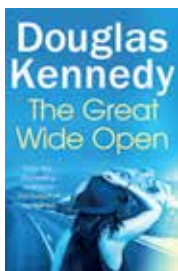
