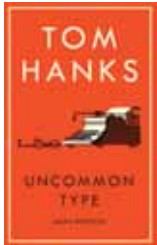

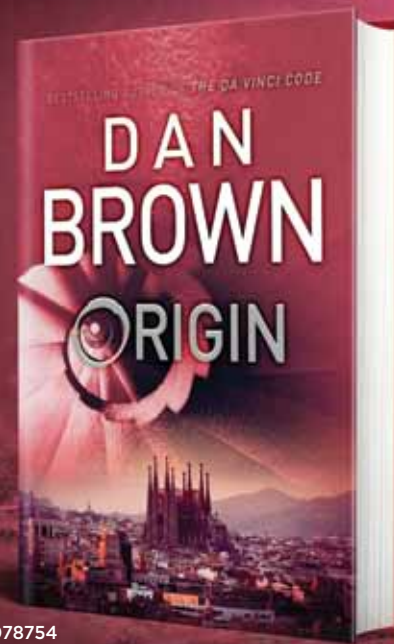
UNCOMMON TYPE**Tom Hanks**

ENDURANCE

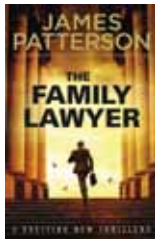
Scott Kelly
