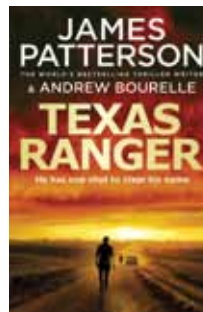
HOW I LOSE YOU

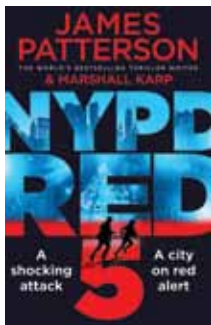

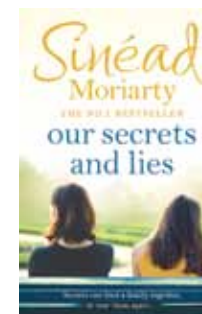
