
IRENE MUCHEMI-NDIRITU

Regret Belongs to the Past

Mikki Brammer's *The Collected Regrets of Clover* is a big-hearted and life-affirming debut about a death doula who, in caring for others at the end of their life, has forgotten how to live her own.



As someone who had long had anxieties around the topic of death, I realised that what made it scarier was that nobody really seemed to talk about it in Western society. And books about the topic often felt so depressing, which made me avoid them! So I wanted to find a way to make death more palatable, and to present everything I'd learned about mortality, grief and regret in a way that was fun, optimistic and joyful.

Before writing the book, and, as a way to explore my own anxiety about death, I had challenged myself to be as curious as I could about mortality and grief by reading articles and listening to podcasts. And then I discovered that it's quite easy to go down a death-related rabbit hole in New York City. As well as death cafés (which are a real thing!), I attended everything from lectures about Stoic philosophy, to message circles (kind of like seances), and talks on the most common regrets of the dying. I also read a lot of books – from the *Tibetan Book of the Dead* to Atul Gawande's *Being Mortal* – and listened to





the experiences of death doulas, nurses, doctors, hospice workers, and other people who have spent time ushering others through the dying process. My goal was to absorb as many perspectives as possible and then use Clover's journey in the book to try to convey the things I found most interesting and poignant – and that might be most helpful to people who shared my anxiety. Most of all, I wanted to do it in a way that was optimistic and fun rather than morbid and depressing!

Aside from considering what my own definition of 'living a beautiful life' would be, I think the most important thing I learned was how to hold space for someone who is dying or grieving. What's interesting is that the things we think might be helpful - like trying to be as positive as possible - can actually make things harder. I learned that it's important to let people be sad and talk about their regrets as much as it is to focus on the positive things in their lives. And also that everybody's grief is their own and everyone deals with it differently, so the most valuable thing you can do is to just listen rather than try to fix things. We often put so much pressure on ourselves to say the right thing in these situations, when the 'right' thing doesn't actually exist, or it might differ from one day to the next, depending on how the person is feeling.

My hope is that readers will get so caught up in Clover's story that they will be more open to considering those topics in relation to their own lives, without feeling like they're being preached to. I also hope it helps contribute to more open, comfortable conversations about death and grief in society in general."

"Ideas come to me all the time. I've been known to pull the car over or interrupt a conversation to jot something down before I forget (because I will always forget if not). I take notes constantly. I keep them on my phone's notes app because I'm rarely without my phone. When I'm working on a first draft, I keep a running list of scenes or details to incorporate at some

point, and use the note for inspiration as I work. When I'm working through a revision, I keep notes of specific changes or additions to make, and then I use the note more as a check-list when I sit down to edit.

One thing I need in order to write, no matter where or when, is a cup of hot tea. I have a hard time settling in to write

without one. But I wish I had a writing desk of my own! Before the pandemic, I always wrote at local coffee shops where I stay in Toronto. I love the atmosphere, the background noise, nosily eavesdropping on bits of conversation. These days I've mostly been writing at my kitchen table after the kids are off to pre-school and kindergarten."







SIR TERRY PRATCHETT





In Conversation with LESLEY PEARSE

Lesley Pearse worked her way through a number of jobs, including nanny, bunny girl, dressmaker and full-time mother before, at the age of forty-nine, she became a published writer. With her new book, *Betrayal*, hitting shelves, Lesley chats about the book and the act of betrayal.

Was there a specific moment that sparked the idea for this book? Where did the idea come from?

I've been betrayed by people a few times, and it hurts. You rarely see it coming which makes it such a shock. But the book is not my story. Whether it is the man in your life cheating on you, a good friend passing on your innermost secrets, or a close relative stealing from you, it's equally bad.

What is it that draws you to writing about domestic life, and the secrets it may harbour?

It's what I know, I've experienced brutality, poverty, abandonment, and success, and of course joy and love. So I write from the heart.

Your characters are so convincing that the reader might be inclined to think that you are writing from experience. How do you manage to write characters so convincingly?

I have experienced nasty stuff, but I don't put any of those incidents in my books. It has made me wiser about people, intrigued by them too. I study them. But you don't have to kill someone to get a very good idea how it will feel.

What is your secret to creating suspense in your books?

I don't have a secret exactly, its more living the moment I'm writing about, thinking about each of the senses, what I can see, smell, taste. Can I put an edge onto it to make it scarier. I like having characters who aren't what they seem. That can create suspense too.



Who is your favourite character in the book, and why?


I confess I like writing about nasty people, its fun. And giving them their comeuppance. I also enjoy flawed characters, after all most of us have a flaw. Many of the people in *Betrayal* are flawed, or damaged. So I enjoyed George, the smarmy, well bred estate agent, who does something unspeakable. But overall, my absolute favorite was Ollie. Such a kind, sensitive boy, the sort of son we all wish for ourselves. He took command at one point, unasked, and I loved him even more.

You tackle some hard subjects in the book. What was your thinking behind putting these characters in their specific situations?

If all the characters led a blameless life of comfort, that would be dull reading. I believe people like to be taken out of their own lives and into another. If that one is bad, then perhaps they feel glad their own life is safe and normal.

What are you hoping to convey with Betrayal?

That people can escape a bad and troubled life. You can run away and start again; I've done that several times in my life. But I think my mind compass always directs my readers to the importance of love and happiness, which I think is the Holy Grail. I find people who are living half-lives, disappointed that theirs isn't what they hoped for, become bitter and critical of others. I say, 'Be Brave', reach out for what and who you want to be.

Tell us about Happy Place.


Happy Place is the story of Harriet and Wyn, a couple who have been together for the better part of a decade, but broke up fairly recently. For a handful of reasons, they decided to put off telling their friends about the break-up until their annual group trip to Maine, which Harriet is supposed to go on alone. But when she gets there, she finds out the Maine house has been sold, and this is the last-ever trip the friends will have. So she and Wvn decide to fake it for one more week, so their friends can have a perfect last coastal vacation together.

What inspired this idea?

I started with the concept of a couples trip, something that can either be a lot of fun or torturous, depending on how everyone's quirks feed into or push up against one another. I thought that idea had potential for both comedy and stress. and I had a few different ideas of how to amp up both, but I've always loved comedies of remarriage, so I decided to try my hand at making one.

Each of the characters in Happy Place is so distinct. How did you juggle writing all of their personalities while keeping focus on Harriet and Wyn?

This was a real challenge after writing three books with smaller central casts. Even though I felt like I knew all of these characters well, it was a struggle figuring out how to actually get that on the page without relying too heavily on telling the audience about them. What character in Happy Place do you relate

I put a little bit of myself into every character, but I find Harriet's issues painfully relatable. I also relate to some of Sabrina's more ... challenging traits. When she's hosting, she gets into Cruise Director mode, in which she has a very specific idea of how things are supposed to go, and it's really hard for her to let go of that idea when circumstances force her to shift gears.

Why is it so important to Harriet and Wyn to pretend to still be together for this trip?

Harriet is a chronic people-pleaser. Nothing scares her more than causing discord. There's a lot more going on than that, but that's the most obvious reason for the farce: she needs the people around her to be happy, and she's terrified of being the reason they're not.

What do you hope readers take away from reading Happy Place?

It's so easy to feel stuck on a track in your life. And it's easy to keep putting your happiness just beyond an imaginary finish line on that track, instead of hopping the rails. I hope this book can be a reminder to someone that there's no one right path, that they're allowed to change their mind about what they want, and that they deserve to be happy, even if that looks different for them than it does for other people.
